

Main Entrance into school

The 'single yellow line' on Gammons Lane outside of the main entrance is now enforced between the hours of 8.30 - 9.30 and 2.30 - 3.30 . Please **DO NOT** park on this line during these times as you may get a parking ticket. If you have a blue disabled badge please display as usual.

If you are walking to school using the main entrance please **DO NOT** cut through the car park. This breaks the school;s safeguarding procedures for keeping children away from moving vehicles.

Pupil Premium Funding

Your child may qualify for additional funding for the school, which can be used to subsidise school residentials, trips, uniform, clubs and provides a 'free lunch' for this children in Y3-6, if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment Support Allowance
- •Child Tax Credit, (providing you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit)
- •Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- •Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

If you do qualify for these benefits please complete the form available from the school office ASAP!

Please do not accompany your child into the school buildings in the mornings or afternoons. If you need to speak with a teacher, either arrange an appointment with the office or speak to them whilst they are outside of their classrooms. This is to safeguard our children there should not be parents wondering around the school buildings without permission.
